A Skacel Design Team pattern *skacel collection, Inc.*



st ridge) along adjacent edge of piece. Rotate piece again, 90 degrees clockwise; PUK 3 sts (1 st in each CO st) along CO edge = 9 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K4, yo, k1 and mark this stitch, yo, k3, sl1 pwise wyif = 11 sts.

Row 2: P1, knit to last stitch, sl1 pwise wyif.

Set Up Row 3 (work once): K4, (yo, k1) 3x, yo, k3, sl1 pwise wyif = 15 sts.

Row 4 (and all WS rows): Rep Row 2.

Row 5: K4, *yo, knit to marked center spine stitch, yo, k1, yo, knit to last 4 sts, yo, k3, sl1 pwise wyif.

Continue as established in Garter Stitch, increasing at each edge and on either side of center spine stitch on RS rows until about 20 grams of yarn remain. End with 6 rows of Garter Stitch, then bind off all sts loosely.

Crochet Edging: Attach yarn at right edge. *Skip one stitch (each chain of the bound-off round equals 1 stitch), double crochet 5x around the next stitch, skip one, single crochet around the next stitch; repeat from * to opposite corner, single crochet around last stitch. Cut yarn and fasten off.

SKILL LEVEL: Adventurous Beginner

SIZE: 69" (175 cm) wide and 34" (86 cm) long

MATERIALS:

Featured Yarn: HiKoo® Rylie, 50% Baby Alpaca, 25% Mulberry Silk, 25% Linen; 274 yds / 100 g hank; 5 hanks #86.

addi® Needles:

5.0 mm (approx US 8) 60" circular needle

4.5 mm (US size G) crochet hook

or size needed to obtain gauge

Additional Notions: Locking ring stitch marker, tapestry needle

All yarn and needles distributed by **skacel collection, Inc.**

GAUGE: 20 sts and 44 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") in Garter st

To save time, check your gauge and read all instructions thoroughly before beginning.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Garter Tab Cast On: CO 3 sts. Knit 6 rows. At end of the 6th row, do not turn work. Rotate piece 90 degrees clockwise; PUK 3 sts (1 st in each garter
