



Sun Break Kerchief

A Skacel Design Team pattern for *skacel collection, Inc.*



clockwise; PUK 3 sts (1 stitch in each cast on st) along cast on edge = 9 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K4, yo, k1 and mark this stitch, yo, k3, sl1 pwise wyif = 11 sts.

Row 2: P1, k3, purl to last 4 sts, k3, sl1 pwise wyif.

Row 3: K4, *yo, k1; rep from * 2x, end yo, k3, sl1 pwise wyif = 15 sts.

Row 4 (and all WS rows): Rep Row 2.

Row 5: K4, *yo, knit to marked center spine stitch, yo, k1, yo, knit to last 4 sts, yo, k3, sl1 pwise wyif.

Cont as est in St st, increasing at each edge and on either side of center spine stitch until about 10 g of yarn remain (5 g of each color).

End with 6 rows of Garter Stitch, and then bind off all sts loosely.

SKILL LEVEL: Adventurous Beginner

SIZE: 48" (122 cm) wide and 22" (56 cm) long

MATERIALS:

Featured Yarn: Schoppel XL Kleckse Cat Print, 100% Superwash Virgin Merino; 437 yds / 100g hank; One (1) ball each of #2188 and #2192.

addi Needle: 4.0mm (approx US 6) 60" addi® circular needle
or size needed to obtain gauge

Additional Notions: Locking ring stitch marker, tapestry needle

All yarn and needles distributed by skacel collection, Inc.

GAUGE: 16 sts and 28 rows = 10cm x 10cm (4" x 4") in St st

**To save time, check your gauge
and read all instructions thoroughly before beginning.**

INSTRUCTIONS:

Garter Tab Cast On:

With yarns held doubled, CO 3 sts.

Knit 6 rows, but at end of the 6th row, do not turn work.

Rotate piece 90 degrees clockwise; PUK 3 sts (1 stitch in each Garter Stitch ridge) along adjacent edge of piece; rotate piece 90 degrees

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
