# The Cleaning Collection

Designed by Katie Rempe for *skacel collection, Inc.*

With just 3 hanks of **HiKoo® Rub-A-Dub**, you can make all the items in our Cleaning Collection! These include a set of 3 Scrubbies, an Eco-Friendly Wash Cloth, and a Hand Towel. The garter stitch in each pattern makes for a plush, absorbent fabric that can easily be thrown into the washer and dryer. Make sure to avoid fabric softening liquid or sheets, and your Cleaning Collection will stay as absorbent as the first day you used them!



**SKILL LEVEL:**

**SIZE and MATERIALS:**

**Featured Yarn:** **HiKoo® Rub-A-Dub**, 100% Microfiber, 108 yds / 200 g; one (1) hank each of 3 colors.

**addi® Needles & Notions:**

9 mm (approx US 13) straight or circular needle

*or size needed to obtain gauge*

Tapestry needle

*All yarn and needles distributed by **skacel collection Inc.***

**GAUGE:** 8 sts and 16 rows = 4" x 4" in Garter Stitch (for all projects)

## Scrub-A-Dub

**Finished Dimensions:** Approx. 4.5" in circumference (once seamed). Shown one each in Colors #138 (Kermitt), #139 (Smurff), and #140 (Astro).

**INSTRUCTIONS:**

CO 8 sts loosely, leaving a 6" tail or longer.

**Row 1:** Knit all sts.

**Row 2:** K1, SSK, k3, kfb, k1.

Work Rows 1 & 2 until piece measures 10" from CO edge (Fabric will bias).

BO all sts loosely, leaving a 6" tail or longer.

**FINISHING:**

Using one of the tails, sew the CO edge to the BO edge to create a small tube, but do not cut. With the tail still threaded in the needle, run the needle through all the knit bumps at the top of the tube and pull tightly to close the top. Secure the tail with a knot and bury the end inside the scrub. Close the opposite end with the second tail.

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## Rub-a-Scrub

Finished Dimensions: 10" x 10"

When you need something bigger than a *Scrub-a-Dub* but smaller than a towel, this washcloth is the solution!  
Shown in MC #140 (Astro) and CC #139 (Smurff).

### INSTRUCTIONS:

CO 18 sts with MC, loosely.

**Rows 1 - 4:** Knit all sts.

**Rows 5 - 8:** Change to CC and knit all sts.

**Rows 9 - 32:** Change to MC and knit all sts.

**Rows 33 - 36:** Change to CC and knit all sts.

**Rows 37 - 40:** Change to MC and knit all sts.

BO all sts, loosely.

### FINISHING:

Weave in ends.

## Give Me A Hand - Towel

Finished Dimensions: 24" x 10"

A soft, absorbent towel is just the ticket when needing to dry your hands or face.

Shown in MC #138 (Kermitt), CC1 #139 (Smurff), and CC2 #140 (Astro).

### INSTRUCTIONS:

CO 18 sts with CC1, loosely.

**Rows 1 - 4:** Knit all sts.

**Rows 5 & 6:** Change to CC2 and knit all sts.

**Rows 7 - 82:** Change to MC and knit all sts.

**Rows 83 & 84:** Change to CC2 and knit all sts.

**Rows 85 - 88:** Change to MC and knit all sts.

BO all sts, loosely.

### FINISHING:

Weave in ends.

### ABBREVIATIONS:

**approx** approximate(ly)

**BO** Bind Off

**CC** Contrasting / Coordinating Color

**CO** Cast On

**k** knit

**kfb** knit into the front and back of the same stitch

**MC** Main Color

**sl** slip

**SSK** Slip 1 stitch, Slip 1 stitch, Knit the 2 slipped sts together

**st(s)** stitch(es)



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
