Skinny Stripes Cowl

Designed by Chuck Wilmesher for skacel collection, Inc.

SKILL LEVEL:

SIZE and MATERIALS:

Finished Dimensions:

4.5" wide x 32" long (laid flat after blocking) and 64" (circum)

Featured Yarn:

Zitron Form & Farbe, 100% Extrafine Merino Wool Superwash, 55 yds / 100g hank; one (1) hank each of two colors.

addi® Needles & Notions:

15 mm (approx. US 19) 32" circular needle
or size needed to obtain gauge
Stitch marker, tapestry needle

All yarn and needles distributed by skacel collection Inc.



Shown in Color A #54 (Sea) and Color B #52 (Storm).

GAUGE: 6 sts & 14 rnds = 4" x 4" in Garter Stitch (after blocking)

To save time, check your gauge and read all instructions thoroughly before beginning.

INSTRUCTIONS:

***NOTE:** When working stripes, carry the unused yarn up the inside of the cowl, wrapping the strands around each other whenever the color changes. Trapping the carried yarn in this way creates a secure and clean finish on the inside of the garment.*

Using Color A and a Long Tail Cast On, CO 100 sts.

Place a marker and join in the Rnd, being careful not to twist the sts.

Rnd 1 Color A: Purl all sts.

Rnd 2 Color B: Knit all sts.

Rnd 3 Color B: Purl all sts.

Rnd 4 Color A: Knit all sts.

Rnd 5 Color A: Purl all sts.

Rnd 6 Color B: Knit all sts.

Rnd 7 Color B: Purl all sts.

Work Rnds 4 - 7 once more, then work Rnds 4 - 6 once more.

Bind off all sts purlwise in Color B, loosely.

***NOTE:** If having trouble binding off loosely, try using a needle that is two or more sizes larger than the one used to establish gauge.*

FINISHING:

Weave in all ends using a tapestry needle.

Steam block to finished (or desired) measurements.
