



Arrowhead Moebius Cowl

A download pattern designed by Karin Skacel for *skacel collection, Inc.*

SKILL LEVEL: Easy

YARN WEIGHT: Worsted

SIZE: One Size (68" circumference by 8" wide)

MATERIALS:

Featured Yarns:

Reggae Ombre by Schoppel, 100% Merino Wool - 109 yds / 50 g; 4 balls needed. Shown in Color #1511.

Cashmere Queen Uni by Schoppel Wolle, 45% Merino Wool, 35% Cashmere, 20% Silk - 153 yds /50 g; 3 balls needed.



addi Needles:

7 mm (approx US 10) 47" or 60" circular needle
or size needed to obtain gauge

Additional Notions:

Tapestry needle

All yarn and needles distributed by skacel collection, Inc.

GAUGE:

4sts per inch.

*To save time, check your gauge
and read all instructions thoroughly before beginning.*

INSTRUCTIONS:

Note: In moebius knitting, each round is made up of two rings of knitting (the first ring brings the stitch marker to the cable below the working needle, and the second ring brings the stitch marker back onto the working working needle, completing the round).

Using Cat Bordhi's Moebius Cast On (<http://tinyurl.com/3k2gt3>), cast on 240 sts. Place a stitch marker to note the beginning and join to work in the rnd.

Rnd 1: M1, *k6, p6; repeat from * to end of rnd = 481 sts.

Rnd 2 (and all following rnds): *K6, p6; repeat from * to end of rnd (due to the odd number of stitches, the pattern will continue to shift one stitch each rnd).

Work in established pattern for a total of 24 complete rnds.

Note: Make sure to allow approx 45-60 feet of working yarn for the bind off. Adjust number of final rnds, if necessary.

Rnds 25 & 27: Knit.

Rnds 26 & 28: Purl.

Bind off all stitches in knit stitch.

FINISHING:

Weave in tail. Block, if desired.
