

BUBBLE TEA BIAS SCARF

Recommended Yarn

Bubble Tea by **HiKoo**®

52% Superwash Merino Wool, 45% Acrylic, 3% Nylon 175yds/100g hank (2 hanks MC, 1 hank CC) MC: shown in #5007 Black with White CC: shown in #5003 Light Greys



Needles & Notions

- 5mm (approx. US 8) skacel by addi[®]
 Rocket 24" circular needle
 (or size necessary to obtain gauge)
- stitch marker
- tapestry needle
- scissors
- measuring tape

Gauge

4-5 sts = 1" (accurate gauge is not crucial for this project)

Finished Measurements

Notes

The bias construction begins with three stitches, working until the desired width is achieved. You may want to weigh your MC prior to starting and once you have reached your desired width to ensure you have enough yarn remaining for the decrease section.

Scarf body is worked with a single decrease and increase on each right-side row. It is helpful to place a removable stitch marker on the right side. Once desired length is reached, decreases are made on both edges of each right-side row.

Contrasting stripes are placed by slipping the first and last stitch of the row and by adding the CC color to the second stitch of the right-side row. This keeps the edging consistent, otherwise, the colors will cross over rows.

The contrasting stipes can be worked as desired. In the model, contrasting stripes were placed in the following increments: 8", 4", 2.5", 8", 1", 1", 7.5", 2.5", 8", 1", 1". All of the 2 skeins of the MC and 25g of the CC were used in the model.

9.5" wide x 71" long the CC were used in the model.

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Instructions

Set-up section

CO 3 sts with MC

Row 1 (RS): Slp1, (PM to denote RS),

KFB, K1

Row 2 & 4 (WS): slp1, purl to EOR,

(SM), P1

Row 3 (RS): Slp1, (SM), KFB, KFB, K1

Increase section with MC

Row 1 (Inc row): Slp1, (SM), KFB, knit to last 2 sts, KFB, K1 Row 2: Slp1, purl to EOR, (SM), P1

Repeat Rows 1 & 2 until increased to 50 sts or desired width is achieved measuring from CO corner to first stitch with working yarn

Body of scarf with MC

Row 1 (RS): Slp1, (SM), K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, KFB, K1

Row 2 (WS): Slp1, purl to EOR, (SM), P1

Body of scarf - Stripes with CC

Row 1 (RS): Slp1, (SM), K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, KFB, Slp1

Row 2 (WS): Slp1, purl to last stitch,

(SM), SIp1 Cut CC

Decrease section with MC

Row 1 (RS): SIp1, (SM), K2tog, knit to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1

Row 2 (WS): Slp1, purl to last stitch,

(SM), P1

Repeat Rows 1 & 2 until 3 sts remain, knit all three together; pull yarn through to secure final stitch

Finishing

Weave in all ends; block with desired method.

Abbreviations

CC contrasting color

CO cast on EOR end of row Inc increase

K1 knit one stitch

K2tog knit two stitches together

KFB knit front and back

MC main color
P1 purl one stitch
PM place marker
right side

SIp1 slip 1 purlwise, yarn held in back

SM slip stitch marker

St(s) stitch(es) WS wrong side



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
