



## Carolyn's Crocheted Cowl

Designed by Candice Bledsoe for **skacel collection, Inc.**



**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy

### SIZE AND MATERIALS:

Size	Small (4 squares)	Large (8 squares)
Circumference	26"	52"
Depth	8"	8"
Yarn	2 hanks (130 yds)	4 hanks (260 yds)

**Featured Yarn:** HiKoo® *Helix*, 40% Wool, 15% Cotton, 45% Acrylic; 65 yds / 50g hank.

### addi Needles:

10 mm (US N) crochet hook

*or size needed to obtain gauge*

9 mm (approx US 13) circular needle in 20" (40") length

**Additional Notions:** Stitch Markers, tapestry needle

*All yarn and needles distributed by skacel collection, Inc.*

**GAUGE:** Each Granny Square is approx 6" x 6" blocked.

**To save time, check your gauge  
and read all instructions thoroughly before beginning.**

### INSTRUCTIONS:

**Note:** When making chains, be sure not to chain too tightly.

**Granny Square:** [make 4 (8)]

Ch 4, join with a slip stitch to form ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 3, 2 dc into ring (counts as a 3 dc), ch 2, [3 dc into ring, ch 2] 3 times, sl st into top st of first ch-3.

**Rnd 2:** Sl st next 3 sts, ch 3, 2 dc into the ch-2 hole (counts as a 3 dc), ch 2, 3 dc into the same ch-2 hole, ch 2, skip 3 sts, [3 dc into ch-2 hole, ch 2, 3 dc into the same ch-2 hole, ch 2, skip 3 sts] 3 times, sl st into top st of first ch-3.

**Rnd 3:** Sl st next 3 sts, ch 3, 2 dc into the ch-2 hole (counts as a 3 dc), ch 2, 3 dc into the same ch-2 hole, ch 2, skip 3 sts, 3 dc into ch-2 hole, ch 2, skip 3 sts, [3 dc into ch-2 hole, ch 2, 3 dc into the same ch-2 hole, ch 2, skip 3 sts, 3 dc into ch-2 hole, ch 2, skip 3 sts] 3 times, sl st into top st of first ch-3.

### Sewing Together:

Holding squares 1 and 2, with right-sides facing each other, single crochet along one edge to join squares. In the same manner join square 3 to square 2, and so on, ending by joining the last square to the first square with single crochet to form a circle.

### Edges:

**Note:** Once sewn into a loop, finish the edges with either crochet or knitting as follows:

### Crocheted Edge:

Working along one edge, sc into each stitch to end of round; slip the first sc of the round, then sc into each stitch to end of round. Fasten off and weave in ends. Work the same two-round, single crochet edging on opposite edge of cowl.

### Knitted Edge:

Pick up and knit 72 (144) sts around one edge.

**Rnd 1:** Purl

**Rnd 2:** Knit

**Rnd 3:** Purl

Bind off all sts knitwise.

Work the same knitted edge on opposite edge of cowl.

### FINISHING:

Weave in all ends and block, if desired.
