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SimpliCria Cabled Cowl

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate SIZE and MATERIALS:

Finished Dimensions: 5" wide x 30" long

Featured Yarn: HiKoo® SimpliCria, 100% Super Baby Alpaca; 95 yds

/ 25g ball; three (3) balls.

addi® Needles:

5.5 mm (approx US 9) circular, straight, or long double point needles. or size needed to obtain gauge

Additional Notions: Stitch markers, cablestitch holder (or 8" circular needle), tapestry needle, three (3) buttons

All yarn and needles distributed by skacel collection, Inc.

STITCH PATTERN:

Garter Stitch: Knit every row.

GAUGE:

24 sts and 36 rows = $10 \text{ cm x } 10 \text{ cm } (4^{\circ} \text{ x } 4^{\circ}) \text{ in Garter Stitch}$

To save time, check your gauge and read all instructions thoroughly before beginning.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Using the long tail cast on method, CO 42 sts (includes edge sts).

Note: Always work edge sts by knitting the first stitch of every row, and, while holding the yarn in front, slipping the last stitch. This creates a very nice and even edging for your cowl.

Work stitch pattern below for 16 rows (the cast on counts as Row 1, and the Set Up Row counts as Row 2).

Set Up Row (WS): Edge st, k10, PM, p2, k2, p2, k2, p2, PM, p2, k2, p2, k2, p2, PM, k10, edge st.

Odd Rows (RS): Edge st, k10, SM, k2, p2, k2, p2, k2, SM, k2, p2, k2, p2, k2, SM, k10, edge st.

Even Rows (WS): Edge st, k10, SM, p2, k2, p2, k2, p2, SM, p2, k2, p2, SM, k10, edge st.

On Row 17 and every 14th row thereafter, cross your center 20 sts for a cable as follows:

Cable Row: Edge st, k10, SM, work the 10-Stitch Cable over the next 20 sts (remove and replace the stitch marker as needed), SM, k10, edge st.

Continuing in est pat, work cable a total of 15 times, then work an additional 9 rows in est pat.

On next row, create buttonholes as follows:

Buttonhole Row: Edge st, k3, work 4-Stitch 1-Row Buttonhole, k3, SM, k2, p2, k2, p2, work 4-Stitch 1-Row Buttonhole (remove marker in process), p2, k2, p2, k2, SM, k3, work 4-Stitch 1-Row Buttonhole, k3, edge st.

Work 10 rows in est pat, starting with an even row.

On the following row, bind off all sts in pat.

FINISHING:

It is not necessary to block this piece.

Sew buttons into the cable as shown in photo.

TECHNIQUES:

10 Stitch Cable:

Slip 10 sts to cable needle purlwise (8" addi circular needles work great) and hold to back of work, work next 10 sts in est pat, then work 10 sts from cable needle in est pat.

4-Stitch 1-Row Buttonhole:

Bring the working yarn to the front, slip the next stitch purlwise, and return the working yarn to the back (this wraps the slipped stitch). *Slip

the next stitch on the left needle purlwise and bring the previous stitch over it and off the needle. Rep from * 2 more times, then slip the stitch on the right needle back to the left needle. Turn the work, and cable cast on 4 stitches to the left hand needle and turn the work. Slip the first stitch on the left needle to the right needle, then pass the last cast on stitch over the slipped stitch. Cont with pat.
