SKILL LEVEL: Easy

SIZE AND MATERIALS:

One Size: Approx 5" x 90"

Featured Yarn: Zauberball Crazy by Schoppel Wolle - 75% Merino Superwash, 25% Nylon - 459 yds / 100g (one ball).
Shown in Color #2099.

Also required: One 24" addi Turbo® circular needle in size 3.75 mm (approx US 5), or size needed to obtain gauge; tapestry needle.

All yarn and needles distributed by skacel collection, Inc.

STITCH PATTERN:

Reversible Point Pattern:

Rows 1, 3, 5, & 7: K3, yo, k12, sl2tog, k1, p2sso, k12, yo, k3.

Rows 2, 4, & 6: K3, p27, k3.

Row 8: Knit.

Row 9: K3, p27, k3.

Repeat Rows 1 – 9.

GAUGE:

26 sts and 30 rows = 4" x 4"

*To save time, read all instructions
thoroughly before beginning.*

INSTRUCTIONS:

CO 33 sts.

Knit 3 rows.

Switch to Reversible Point Pattern and work until scarf reaches desired length, or until approximately 5 yards of yarn remain.

Knit 3 rows.

BO all sts.

Weave in loose ends and block lightly.

ABBREVIATIONS:

BO Bind Off

CO Cast On


k knit

p purl

p2sso pass 2 slipped stitches over (stitch just knitted)

sl2tog Slip 2 stitches together as if to knit 2 stitches together

yo yarn over



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
