SKILL LEVEL: 

SIZE and MATERIALS:

Finished Dimensions: Approx. 36" circumference x 22" long

Featured Yarn: Schoppel Zauberwolle, 100% Virgin Wool Merino, 273yds / 100g ball, (2) two balls.

addi® Needles & Notions:

4mm (approx. US F) addi® hook

or size(s) needed to obtain gauge

Tapestry needle, stitch marker.

All yarn and needles distributed by skacel collection Inc.

GAUGE: *Not critical for this project*

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INSTRUCTION

Chain for 36". Join the chain in the round using a slip stitch. Chain three, then work a half-double crochet into each chain stitch, working into the back bump of each stitch. When you arrive at the beginning of the round, work a slip stitch into the top chain of the initial chain three to join. Place marker.

Round 1: Chain three, then work half-double crochet into the FRONT loop of each chain stitch. At the end of the round, join to the top chain of the previous chain-three with a slip stitch.

Round 2: Chain three, then work half-double crochet into the BACK loop of each chain stitch. At the end of the round, join to the top chain of the previous chain-three with a slip stitch.

Repeat these two rounds until piece measures 22" long, or desired length.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block gently, if desired.



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
