



## Kittenish Pullover

A free pattern download by **skacel collection, Inc.**

*To save time, check your gauge and read all instructions thoroughly before beginning.*

### INSTRUCTIONS:

#### Yoke:

With shorter circular needle, CO 22 (22, 24, 26, 26) sts. Do not join.

**Set Up Row:** With WS facing, purl 1 row and **at the same time**, PM after 1 stitch to denote Right Front, p2, PM to denote Right Sleeve, p16 (16, 18, 20, 20), PM to denote Back, p2, PM to denote Left Sleeve. There will remain 1 stitch for Left Front.

**Note:** When working yoke, change to longer circular needle as necessary to accommodate the larger number of stitches.

#### Shape Neck and Shoulders:

**Note:** Stitches are cast on to shape the Front neck. At the same time, increases are worked on each side of each marker to shape the yoke. Read the following sections completely before proceeding.

Work following Inc Row / Rnd, as specified, to shape yoke:

**Inc Row or Rnd (RS):** \*Work to 1 stitch before next marker, kfb, SM, kfb; rep from \* 3 more times (8 sts inc).

Continuing in St st, work Inc Row / Rnd every other row / rnd 14 (15, 16, 16, 19)x, then every 4th row / rnd 1 (2, 2, 3, 2)x.

**At the same time**, after working 6 rows from Set Up Row, shape crewneck as follows: Using Knitted Cast On, CO 1 stitch at each Front neck edge every RS row 0 (0, 1, 0, 0)x. CO 2 sts at each Front neck edge 1 (2, 1, 2, 2)x. CO 3 sts at each Front neck edge 1 (0, 0, 0, 0)x. On next RS row, CO 4 (6, 10, 10, 10) sts for center Front, knit across row, and join sts to work in the rnd.

Continue working Inc Row / Rnd as established. After all incs have been completed there will be 156 (172, 184, 196, 212) sts: 46 (50, 54, 58, 62) sts each for Back and Front and 32 (36, 38, 40, 44) sts for each Sleeve.

#### Divide for Body and Sleeves:

Removing markers as they appear, \*k46 (50, 54, 58, 62), slip 32 (36, 38, 40, 44) sleeve sts to waste yarn. Using Knitted Cast On, CO 3 sts, PM (marks Right Side), CO 3 sts; rep from \* once (second marker marks Left Side) = 104 (112, 120, 128, 136) sts.

#### Lower Body:

Work even until piece meas 7" (8", 9.5", 10.5", 11.5") from division for Sleeves.

Bind off all sts using Picot Bind Off.



**SKILL LEVEL:** Intermediate

**Featured Yarn:** *Simpliworsted Marl* by HiKoo, 55% Merino, 28% Acrylic, 17% Nylon; 140 yds / 100g hank. Shown in #652 (Pretty as a Petunia).

#### SIZE & MATERIALS:

Pullover Sizing (Sample shown is 26")					
Finished Chest Measurement	26"	28"	30"	32"	34"
Yarn in skeins	3	4	4	5	6

#### addi Needles

5.5 mm (approx US 9) 16" circular needle

5.5 mm (approx US 9) 24" circular needle

5.5 mm (approx US 9) double pointed needles (Set of 4 or 5)

**Additional Notions:** Stitch markers (4-6), tapestry needle, waste yarn

#### STITCH PATTERNS:

**Stockinette Stitch:** Knit on RS; purl on WS.

**Stockinette Stitch in the Rnd:** Knit all rounds.

**Garter Stitch in the Rnd:** Alternate one knit rnd and one purl round.

*All yarn and needles distributed by skacel collection Inc.*

**Gauge:** 16 sts and 20 rows = 4" x 4" in Stockinette Stitch

## Sleeves: (work 2)

Transfer the 32 (36, 38, 40, 44) sts on hold for Sleeve back to the shorter circular needle or DPNs. With WS facing, join new yarn, pick up and knit 1 stitch into each of the 3 CO sts, transfer marker (will mark end of rnd), pick up and knit 1 stitch into the next 3 CO sts. Join in the rnd = 38 (42, 44, 46, 50) sts.

## Taper Sleeve:

**Note:** Change to DPNs when there are too few sts to fit comfortably on the circular needle.

Work even until sleeve meas 1" from joining rnd.

Work following Dec Rnd every 6th rnd 7 (8, 8, 8, 9)x = 24 (26, 28, 30, 32) sts.

**Dec Rnd:** Work to 3 sts before marker, k2tog, k1, SM, k1, SSK.

Work even until Sleeve meas 10" (10.5", 12", 12.75", 13.5") from joining rnd.

Bind off all sts using Picot Bind Off.

Work second Sleeve as first.

## FINISHING

Working around the neck opening and beginning at the back right raglan line, pick up and knit 1 stitch for each cast on st and 3 sts for every 4 rows along the sloped edges of the neck opening.

Join and work 6 rnds of Garter Stitch.

Bind off all sts using Picot Bind Off.

Weave in all ends and block gently.


## ABBREVIATIONS:

<b>BO</b>	Bind Off
<b>CO</b>	Cast On
<b>DPN</b>	Double Point Needles
<b>inc(s)</b>	increase(s) / increasing
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>kfb</b>	knit into the front and back of the same stitch
<b>meas</b>	measures
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>PM</b>	Place Marker
<b>rnd(s)</b>	round(s)
<b>RS</b>	Right Side
<b>sl</b>	slip (unless otherwise stated, slip as if to purl)
<b>SM</b>	Slip Marker
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>St st</b>	Stockinette Stitch
<b>WS</b>	Wrong Side
<b>x</b>	times

## TECHNIQUES:

### Picot Bind Off:

\*CO 2 sts to left hand needle using Cable Cast On, immediately BO 4 sts, slip remaining stitch on right hand needle back to left hand needle and rep from \* until all stitches are bound off.
