- 3.75 mm (approx US 5) 16" circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge
- Stitch markers
- Two (2) 1" buttons
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch holders

## Stitch Pattern:

 Basket Weave Pattern:(multiple of $4+3$ sts)
Rows 1 \& 3 (RS): Knit.
Row 2: *K3, p1;
repeat from * to last 3 sts, k3.
Row 4: K1, *p1, k3;
repeat from * to last 2 sts, p1, k1.
Repeat Rows 1-4 for pat.

## Gauge:

23 sts $\times 33$ rows $=4$ " $\times 4$ " ( $10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) in Basket Weave pat

To save time, check your gauge and read all instructions thoroughly before beginning.

## Instructions

## Back:

CO $105(113,121,133,141)$ sts.
Knit 1 row.
Next Row (RS): K1, work Row 1 of Basket Weave pat over the next 103 (111, 119, 131, 139) sts, K1.
Next Row: P1, work Row 2 of Basket Weave pat over the next 103 (111, 119, 131, 139) sts, P1.

Work in pat as est, dec 1 stitch at EACH edge every 4" a total of $3 x=99$ (107, 115, 127, 135) sts.

NOTE: Work decs 1 stitch in from the edge, so as to maintain 1 St st at each edge (makes for easier seaming).

Work until piece meas 12" (13.5", 14", 14.5", 14.5").
Place a marker at each end of the next row to mark beg of armhole.
Cont in pat until piece meas a total of 20" (22", 23", 24", 24").
Place all $99(107,115,127,135)$ sts on a holder.

## Right Front:

CO 69 (77, 81, 89, 93) sts.
Knit 1 row.
Next Row (RS): K1, work Row 1 of Basket Weave pat over the next 67 (75, 79, 87, 91) sts, K1.
Next Row: P1, work Row 2 of Basket Weave pat over the next 67 (75, 79, 87, 91) sts, P1.

Work in pat as est, dec one st at the END of a RS row every 4" a total of $3 x-66(74,78,86,90)$ sts.

NOTE: Work decs 1 stitch in from the edge, so as to maintain 1 St st at each edge (makes for easier seaming).

Work even until piece meas $12^{\prime \prime}$ (13.5", 14", $\left.14.5^{\prime \prime}, 14.5^{\prime \prime}\right)$, ending after working a WS row.
Place a marker at SIDE EDGE of the next row to mark beg of the armhole.

Cont in pat until piece meas a total of $14.5^{\prime \prime}$ (16.5", 17.5", 18.5", 18.5"), ending after working a WS row.

Next Row (RS): BO $28(34,36,40,42)$ sts, work in est pat to the end.
Work 1 WS row.
Next Row: Dec 1 stitch at NECK EDGE every 4th row $5 x$, then EVERY OTHER row $5 x$ in the following manner:

K1, SSK, work to end of row $=28(30,32,36,38)$ sts after all decs.
Next: Keeping first NECK EDGE stitch in St st, work even until piece meas 20" (22", 23", 24", 24").

Put all $28(30,32,36,38)$ sts for right shoulder on a holder.

## Left Front:

CO $47(53,53,61,61)$ sts.
Knit 1 row.
Next Row (RS): K1, work Row 1 of Basket Weave pat over the next 45 (51, 51, 59, 59) sts, K1.

Next Row: P1, work Row 2 of Basket Weave pat over the next $45(51,51$, $59,59)$ sts, P1.

Keeping the first and last stitch in St st, work in pat as est, dec 1 stitch at the beg of a RS row every $4 "$ a total of $3 x=44(50,50,58,58)$ sts after all decs.

Work even until piece meas 12 " (13.5", 14 ", $14.5^{\prime \prime}, 14.5^{\prime \prime}$ ).
Place a marker at SIDE EDGE of the next row to mark beg of the armhole.

Cont in est pat until piece meas a total of $14.5^{\prime \prime}$ (16.5", $\left.17.5^{\prime \prime}, 18.5,18.5^{\prime \prime}\right)$, ending after working a RS row.

Next Row (WS): BO $6(10,8,12,10)$ sts, work in est pat to end of row.
Next Row: Dec 1 st at NECK EDGE every 4th row $5 x$, then EVERY OTHER row $5 x$ in the following manner:

K1, work to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1 = $28(30,32,36,38)$ sts after all decs.
Keeping first NECK EDGE stitch in St st, work even until piece meas 20" (22", 23", 24", 24").

Put all $28(30,32,36,38)$ sts for left shoulder on a holder.

## Sleeves: (make 2)

CO 73 ( $81,85,93,93$ ) sts.
Knit 1 row.
Work 4 rows in Basket Weave pat.
Next Row (RS): Inc 1 stitch at each end of the NEXT AND FOLLOWING 4th row, for a total of $11 x=95(103,107,115,115)$ sts after all decs.

NOTE: Work incs 1 stitch in from the edge, so as to maintain 1 St st at each edge (makes for easier seaming).

Work until piece meas 5" (or desired length), ending after working a WS row.

Bind off all sts knitwise.

## FINISHING:

Right Shoulder Seam: Move the $28(30,32,36,38)$ sts to a working needle from the right side of the stitch holder that is holding the Back sts. Use a Three Needle Bind Off to join these sts together with the Right Front shoulder sts.

Left Shoulder Seam: Move the $28(30,32,36,38)$ sts to a working needle from the left side of the stitch holder that is holding the Back sts. Use a Three Needle Bind Off to join these sts together with the Left Front shoulder sts.

Sew in sleeves, fitting them between the markers. Sew side and sleeve seams.

Button Band: With RS facing, PUK 3 sts for every 4 rows along the edge of the Left Front.

Knit 1 row.
Bind off all sts knitwise.
Buttonhole Band: With RS facing, PUK 3 sts for every 4 rows along the edge of the Right Front.
Knit 2 rows.
Next Row (WS): K6, YO, k2tog, k6, YO, k2tog, knit to end.
Knit 2 rows.
Bind off all sts knitwise.
Neck Band: With RS facing, and beg at the TOP of the Right Front edge, PUK 3 sts for every 4 rows around the neck working the Back neck sts off the holder as necessary, ending at the TOP of the Left Front edge.

Knit 1 row.
Bind off all sts knitwise.
Sew buttons in place.
