Wayside Lace Cardigan

Knit an enveloping shawl-like cardigan with generous fronts that can be worn cascading open, or wrapped and pinned into a cozy wrap. This sweater is the perfect showcase for *Schoppel-Wolle Cashmere Queen*, a lightly felted DK-weight single that is a blend of soft wool, lustrous silk and feather-light cashmere. The crisp stitch definition is ideal for the simple cables and delicate lace panels.

The Wayside Cardigan is an all-around delight!

Materials

9 (11) balls <u>Cashmere Queen by Schoppel-Wolle</u>; 45% merino wool, 35% cashmere, 20% silk. 153 yds / 50 g. Shown in Color #7873.

Size

XS/S (M/L) Note: fronts have a generous amount of fabric and will fit a wide range of sizes wrapped and pinned or hanging freely; we recommend choosing a size based on your back measurement (see schematic).

Gauge

25 sts + 28 rows = 4" in Wayside Lace Pattern

Needles + **Notions**

US 4 / 3.5mm 32" addi Turbo circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge Cable needle Tapestry needle

all yarn and needles distributed by skacel collection inc.

Note

Cardigan is knit sideways in one piece, sleeves are set into armholes after. Arrows in schematic indicate direction of knitting.

Wayside Lace Pattern

Multiple of 40 + 9 border sts + 2 selv sts. Work according to chart (note: border ribbing and selv sts are not charted: beg each row by slipping the first st kwise, p1, k1, p1, k1, p1, work from chart to last 5 sts then k1, p1, k1, p1, end k1). Only RS rows are charted. On WS rows, work all sts as they appear; p all YOs.

Directions

Body

CO 171 sts and work in Wayside Lace pattern. Cont until work meas 34.5 (38.5) cm from CO edge. Shape first armhole: work first 96 (86 sts) in patt, BO 40 (50) sts and work to end of row in patt. On foll WS row, CO these sts again using backwards loop CO.

Cont until work meas 51.5 (58) cm from CO edge. This is the center back. Cont until work meas 68.5 (77.5) cm from CO edge, then rep armhole shaping as for first. When work meas 103 (116) cm from CO, BO all sts in patt.

Sleeves

CO 63 (81) sts and work Wayside Lace patt as foll: beg with 1 selv st and last 11 (20) sts of patt rep, work patt rep once, end after working first 10 (19) sts of patt rep and 1 selv st. Cont until work meas 19.5 cm = 54 rows from cuff.

Shape sleeve: inc 1 st at each end of next row and on every 4th foll row 14x (on foll 6th row 8x and 4th row 2x) = 93 (103) sts. Work new sts according to patt. Cont until work meas 43 cm from cuff.

Shape top: Cont to work in pattern, BO 4 sts at beg of foll 2 rows, 3 sts at beg of foll 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows, 1 st at beg of next 8 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 6 rows and 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 43 (53) sts. Cont until work meas 51.5 cm from CO edge. BO all sts.

Finishing


Join sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves, easing in sleeve cap if necessary.
