



Simpliworsted Easy Doll's Hat

A free download pattern designed by Walter Quan for **skacel collection, Inc.**



SKILL LEVEL: Easy

YARN WEIGHT: Worsted

SIZE AND MATERIALS:

Size	Small
Head Circumference	Approx 13" - 14"
Yarn	1 hank (140 yds)

FEATURED YARN: Simpliworsted by HiKoo 55% Merino Superwash, 28% Acrylic, & 17% Nylon - 140 yds / 100g. Shown in Color #011 (Indigo).

addi Needles:

5.5 mm (US I) crochet hook

Additional Notions:

Stitch markers, cable needle, tapestry needle

All yarn and needles distributed by skacel collection, Inc.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Hat Body:

Note: The body of this hat is created with two strands crocheted together. One strand is pulled from the center of the ball and one from the outside, and the two are held together until the brim.

Set-up (Rnd 1): Using two strands held tog, Ch 4, join with slip stitch to make a ring.

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (counts as first dc in the rnd), 11 dc in ring, join with sl st first dc (the ch-2 at the beginning of the rnd). (12 dc)

Rnd 3: Ch 2 (counts as first dc in the rnd), dc into first stitch, then 2dc into each of the remaining sts, join with sl st to first dc. (24 dc)

Rnd 4: Ch 2 (counts as first dc), *2 dc into first st, dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd, join with sl st to first dc. (36 stitches)

Rnd 5: Ch 2 (counts as first dc), *2 dc into first st, dc into each of next 2 sts; rep from * to end of rnd, join with sl st to first dc. (48 stitches)

Rnd 6: Ch 2 (counts as first dc), *2 dc into first st, dc into each of next 3 sts; rep from * to end of rnd, join with sl st to first dc. (60 stitches)

Rnds 7 - 11: Ch 2 (counts as first dc), dc in each st around, join with sl st to first dc. (60 sts)

Brim:

Rnd 12: Ch 1 (counts as first sc), sc in each front loop around, join with sl st to first sc.

Rnd 13: Using a single strand of yarn (no longer double), ch 1 (counts as first sc), sc in each front loop around, join with sl st to first sc.

Rnd 14: Using the other SINGLE strand of yarn (the one dropped at Rnd 13), ch 1 (counts as first sc), sc in each front loop around, join with sl st to first sc.

Rnd 15: Repeat as for Rnd 13.

Rnd 16: Repeat as for Rnd 14.

This should leave a small amount of yarn left, which can be crocheted along or sewn in to hide.

Stretch the brim a bit and allow it curl up.

FINISHING:

Block as necessary although the doubling of the yarn makes the hat hold a shape fairly readily.
