



## Swirly Hat

**SKILL LEVEL:** Intermediate

### SIZE & MATERIALS:

Finished Size: Circumference at brim = 19.5".

**Featured Yarn:** HiKoo® Zumie, 30% Wool, 50% Acrylic, 20% Nylon;

110 yds / 200g hank (one hank)

### addi® Needles

9 mm (approximate US 13) 16" circular needle

9 mm (approximate US 13) DPNs

**Additional Notions:** Stitch marker, cable needle, tapestry needle

*All yarn and needles distributed by skacel collection, Inc.*

**Gauge:** 7 sts and 11 rows = 4" x 4" in Swirl Pattern

**To save time, check your gauge  
and read all instructions thoroughly before beginning.**

### STITCH PATTERN:

**Note:** Marker must be removed and replaced as indicated, in order for the Swirl Pattern to develop. On odd numbered rows, marker is simply slipped.

**Swirl Pattern:** (worked over a multiple of 20 sts)

**Rnd 1:** \*Sl1, k1; repeat from \* to end of rnd.

**Rnd 2:** \*LT, (LTP) 4x, (k1, p1) 5x; repeat from \* to end of rnd, **RM**, sl1, **PM**.

**Rnd 3:** \*Sl1, (k1, sl1) 4x, sl1, (k1, sl1) 4x, k1, sl1; repeat from \* to end of rnd.

**Rnd 4:** \*(LTP) 5x, (p1, k1) 4x, p1, k1; repeat from \* to end of rnd, **RM**, sl1, **PM**.

Repeat Rnds 1 - 4 for pattern.

### INSTRUCTIONS:

#### Hat:

CO 60 sts, PM and join to work in the rnd, making sure not to twist sts. Work in Swirl Pattern for 5.5", ending after working Rnd 3.

#### Decreases:

**Notes:** At this point, work can be done using Chart or text. Red and Green abbreviations in text and chart correspond with chart legend.

**Rnd 1 (Dec):** [(LTP) 4x, LTPSSK, (k1, p1) 4x, k1] 3x (= 57 sts), **RM**, sl1.

**Rnd 2:** **PM**, [(Sl1, k1) 4x, sl1, (sl1, k1) 5x] 3x = 57 sts.

**Rnd 3:** [LT, (LTP) 4x, (p1, k1) 4x, p1] 3x (= 57 sts), **RM**, sl1.

**Rnd 4:** **PM**, [(SL1, k1) 9x, sl1] 3x = 57 sts.

**Rnd 5 (Dec):** [(LTP) 4x, LTPSSK, (p1, k1) 4x] 3x (= 54 sts), **RM**, sl1.

**Rnd 6:** **PM**, (SL1, k1) 27x = 54 sts.

**Rnd 7:** [LT, (LTP) 4x, (k1, p1) 4x] 3x (= 54 sts), **RM**, sl1.

**Rnd 8:** **PM**, [(SL1, k1) 4x, sl1] 6x (= 54 sts).

**Rnd 9 (Dec):** [(LTP) 4x, LTPSSK, (k1, p1) 3x, k1] 3x (= 51 sts), **RM**, sl1.

**Rnd 10:** **PM**, [(SL1, k1) 4x, sl1, (sl1, k1) 4x] 3x (= 51 sts).

**Rnd 11 (Dec):** [LT, (LTP) 3x, LTPSSK, (k1, p1) 3x] 3x (= 48 sts), **RM**, sl1.

**Rnd 12:** **PM**, [(SL1, k1) 4x, sl1, (sl1, k1) 3x, sl1] 3x (= 48 sts).

**Rnd 13 (Dec):** [(LTP) 4x, LTPSSK, (k1, p1) 2x, k1] 3x (= 45 sts), **RM**, sl1.

**Rnd 14:** **PM**, [(SL1, k1) 4x, sl1, (SL1, k1) 3x] 3x (= 45 sts).

**Rnd 15 (Dec):** [LT, (LTP) 3x, LTPSSK, (k1, p1) 2x] 3x (= 42 sts), **RM**, sl1.

**Rnd 16:** **PM**, [(SL1, k1) 4x, sl1, (SL1, k1) 2x, sl1] 3x (= 42 sts).

**Rnd 17 (Dec):** [(LTP) 4x, LTPSSK, k1, p1, k1] 3x (= 39 sts), **RM**, sl1.

**Rnd 18:** **PM**, [(SL1, k1) 4x, sl1, (SL1, k1) 2x] 3x (= 39 sts).

**Rnd 19 (Dec):** [LT, (LTP) 3x, LTPSSK, k1, p1] 3x (= 36 sts), **RM**, sl1.

**Rnd 20:** **PM**, [(SL1, k1) 4x, sl2, k1, sl1] 3x (= 36 sts).

**Rnd 21 (Dec):** [(LTP) 4x, LTPSSK, k1] 3x (= 33 sts), **RM**, sl1.

**Rnd 22:** **PM**, [(SL1, k1) 4x, sl2, k1] 3x (= 33 sts).

**Rnd 23 (Dec):** [LT, (LTP) 3x, LTPSSK] 3x (= 30 sts), **RM**, sl1.

**Rnd 24:** **PM**, [(SL1, k1) 4x, sl2] 3x (= 30 sts).

**Rnd 25:** [(SSK) 5x] 3x (= 15 sts).

**Rnd 26:** Knit.

Break yarn and pull through remaining stitches. Weave in ends.

#### ABBREVIATIONS:

**CO** Cast On

**k** knit

**LT** (**Left Twist**) Slip one stitch to cable needle and hold to front, knit one stitch, knit stitch from cable needle.

**LTP** (**Left Twist Purl Back**) Slip one stitch to cable needle and hold front, purl one stitch, knit stitch from cable needle.

**LTPSSK** (**Left Twist Purl Back, Slip, Slip, Knit**) Place one stitch on cable needle, hold to front, purl next stitch, place stitch from cable needle back on left needle, slip two stitches, one at a time, and then knit both together through the back loop. (twisted dec)

**p** purl

**PM** Place Marker

**RM** Remove Marker

**rnd(s)** round(s)

**sl** slip as if to purl

**SSK** Slip 2 stitches knit wise, one at a time, from the left needle to the right needle, then insert the left needle into the front of the slipped stitches and knit them together (decreases 1 stitch).

**x** times



<span style="border-top: 1px solid black; border-left: 1px solid black; border-right: 1px solid black; border-bottom: none; padding: 2px 2px 2px 4px;"></span>	= LTP (Left Twist Purl Back)
<span style="border: 1px solid black; border-top: 1px solid black; border-left: 1px solid black; border-right: 1px solid black; border-bottom: 1px solid black; padding: 2px 2px 2px 4px;"></span>	= LTPSSK (Left Twist Purl Back/SSK)

#### Swirl Decreases Chart



**Swirl Pattern:** Repeat between bold lines around, then slip markers as indicated.

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
