



## Camouflage Socks

Designed by Jodi Roush for *skacel collection, Inc.*



**SKILL LEVEL:** Intermediate

**SIZE AND MATERIALS:**

**Featured Yarn:** Zitron *Trekking XXL*, 75% Superwash Wool, 25% Nylon; 459 yds / 100g. Shown in color #595.

**addi Needles:**

2.25 mm 32" circular needles or DPNs (pattern written for Magic Loop)  
or size needed to obtain gauge

**Additional Notions:** Stitch Markers, tapestry needle

All yarn and needles distributed by *skacel collection, Inc.*

**STITCH PATTERN:**

**K2 x P2 Rib:** (multiple of 4 sts)

**Rnd 1:** \*K2, p2; repeat from \* to end of rnd.

Repeat Rnd 1 for pattern.

**Stockinette Stitch:** Knit all rnds.

**GAUGE:** 32 sts and 42 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") in St st

**To save time, check your gauge and read all instructions thoroughly before beginning.**

**INSTRUCTIONS:**

**Note:** To achieve the optimal camouflage patterning in these socks, the gauge must be 8 sts per inch.

Cuff:

Loosely CO 68 sts, place marker and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

Work in K2 x P2 Rib for 2".

Work in St st for 6".

Heel:

Work heel over 34 sts as follows:

**Row 1 (RS):** RM, (Sl1, k1) 17x, turn.

**Row 2:** Sl1, p33, turn.

Rep Rows 1 & 2 for a total of 34 rows.

Turn Heel:

**Row 1:** Knit 19, ssk, k1, turn.

**Row 2:** Sl1, p5, p2tog, p1, turn.

**Row 3:** Sl1, knit to 1 stitch before last turn, ssk, k1, turn.

**Row 4:** Sl1, purl to 1 stitch before last turn, p2tog, p1, turn.

Repeat Rows 3 & 4 until all stitches have been worked, ending with

Row 4 and p2tog only = 20 sts.

Gusset:

K20, PUK 17 sts along heel flap edge, PM, knit 34 sts from instep, PM, PUK 17 sts along heel flap edge = 88 sts.

**Rnd 1:** Knit to 3 sts before marker, k2tog, k1, knit to marker, k1, ssk, knit to end of rnd.

**Rnd 2:** Knit.

Rep Rnds 1 & 2 until 68 sts remain.

Work even in St st until 2" from desired length of foot.

Toe:

**Rnd 1:** (K1, ssk, knit to 3 sts before marker, k2tog, k1, sm) 2x.

**Rnd 2:** Knit.

Work Rnds 1 & 2 a total of 8x = 36 sts.

Rep Rnd 1 until 12 sts remain.

**FINISHING:**

Use the Kitchener Stitch to graft together the 6 sts of the top of the toe to the 6 sts of the bottom of toe.

Weave in all ends.

**ABBREVIATIONS:**

- k** knit
- k2tog** knit 2 stitches together (decreases 1 stitch)
- p** purl
- p2tog** purl 2 stitches together (decreases 1 stitch)
- PM** Place Marker
- PUK** Pick Up and Knit
- RM** Remove Marker
- St st** Stockinette Stitch
- rnd(s)** round(s)
- sl** slip (unless otherwise stated, slip as if to purl)
- sm** slip marker
- ssk** Slip 2 stitches knit wise, one at a time, from the left needle to the right needle, then insert the left needle into the front of the slipped stitches and knit them together (decreases 1 stitch).

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
